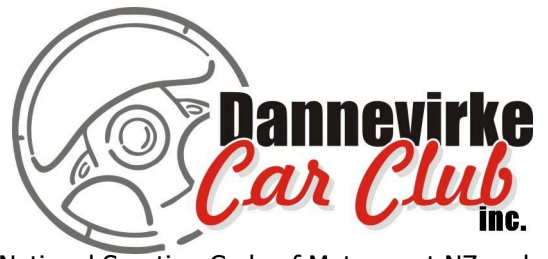


Prenters Metal Pit Autocross

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS



(1) JURISDICTION

Promoted by Dannevirke Car Club Inc. Held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport NZ and these Supplementary Regulations.

(2) PERMIT:

Motorsport NZ Clubsport Basic. Permit number tba.

(3) OFFICIALS:

CLERKS OF COURSE: Daniel Feck, TBA

SCRUTINEER: William Menzies, Carl Brown and nominated helper.

FIRST AID: Liz Feck or TBA

(4) VENUE/TIME:

Prenters Metal Pit, off Weber rd, east of Dannevirke.

Gather from 9:30 am for Documentation and Scrutineering. Drivers briefing approximately 10:30am.

(5) DIRECTIONS:

Approximately 4.5km east of Dannevirke on Weber Rd, turn left into the metal pit. Near 351 Weber Rd.

(6) ENTRIES, FEES

\$40, on the day. Please have the correct change to keep it simple for the secretary.

(7) CANCELLATION:

All weather venue. In the unforeseen circumstance of a cancellation we will do our best to advise the prospective entrants we know of.

(8) PROGRAMME:

(a) Documentation and auditing will take place at the venue from 9.30am

(b) Drivers briefing will be held at approximately 10:30am

(c) All timed runs are official.

(d) Please stay afterwards and help with the tidying up.

(9) RESULTS:

(a) Displacement of a cone or marker will result in a 30 second penalty per cone.

(b) Failing to complete the course correctly will result in the competitor being awarded the slowest time of the day, plus five seconds

(c) Results will be e-mailed, and posted on the car club website, unless specifically requested otherwise

(10) FURTHER INFORMATION:

(A) Unwarranted vehicles are eligible to enter, however must be presented looking like they could have a WOF. They will be audited to MSNZ schedule A.

(B) Any vehicle wishing to carry a passenger in the autocross must be fitted with a roll cage, full harness belts, and suitable seating, as per Schedule A Safety, and Schedule C Clubsport regulations. The vehicle must be approved by the Clerk of the Course.

(C) All driving around and outside the venue must be of the highest standard, as should we incur the wrath of the locals we could lose the venue.

(D) Absolutely no parking on the side of Weber road. This is everyone's responsibility to ensure we keep the use of the venue

(E) We have gained access back to this great venue thanks to the goodwill of HIROCK, Higgins family and neighbors. Please ensure you respect the venue and hold everyone else to the same high standards.
